

MT SEPA-INBRE Summer Undergraduate Research Application

5 Week Program: Students receive a stipend of \$2,300. Program dates are June 24 – July 29, 2020 (although there may be flexibility to start and finish a few weeks earlier if requested). Students who will be freshmen college students in Fall 2020 are eligible for this program. **Priority Deadline: March 8th**
Later applications will be considered for funding if we do not reach the program capacity by March 8th.

10 Week Program: Students receive a stipend of \$4,600. Program dates are May 20 – July 29, 2020. Students must be currently enrolled at university to be eligible for this program. **Deadline Feb 23th.**
We do not expect to have the capacity to consider applications received after the Feb 23rd deadline

Travel and accommodations are to be paid by the student. Montana INBRE will arrange for dormitory accommodations as an option for students upon request.

In accordance with MSU policy, hiring will be conditional upon successful completion of a pre-employment background check. Implementation of this program is contingent upon continued funding of the MT INBRE grant.

To be considered for this program you must:

- Participated in classroom phase discovery research as part of Montana Tech's BRIC program.
- Be enrolled as a freshmen, sophomore, junior, or senior in good academic standing during summer term (> 6 credits) or upcoming fall semester (minimum 12 credits)
- Be a US Citizen or authorized to work in the United States

How to apply:

The following application materials are required:

- Application Form completed, dated and signed
- Two letters of (2) recommendation: At least one must be from a current or former professor (or teacher if you are still in high school). The second may be from a current or former professor or from a former employer or a high school teacher. If you have been involved in research previously then you must obtain a reference from your previous research mentor. Your application will not be screened until these are received. These may be emailed separately or included with your mailed application.
- One copy of transcripts for all post-secondary grades completed to date. An unofficial transcript, obtained from your school's website or registrar, is acceptable.
